

- Proposals must include: title, abstract, name of student author(s), e-mail address, and name of faculty sponsor(s).
- Abstracts must clearly identify a research question or policy problem, argument, research strategy utilized, and findings.
- Proposals should be e-mailed, with "2013 MPSURC" in the subject line, to: frederick.slocum@mnsu.edu.
- Deadline for proposals is February 21st.
- Authors of papers accepted for presentation will be notified via e-mail on or before February 27th.

Paper Submissions

Authors of accepted papers must send one copy of their paper to both the panel chair/discussant AND the conference organizer by March 18th.

Best Paper Awards

- Monetary prizes awarded to the two, possibly three, student papers judged best.
- To be eligible for the Best Paper Awards, papers must be submitted by March 11th.
